DISTRICT 24B MONTHLY ACTIVITIES REPORT RICHMOND JAMES RIVER LIONS CLUB JULY 2012

PROGRAMS

JULY 10 - DINNER MEETING - Holiday Inn - Koger Center Our guest speaker was Marcus Ragland, representing Boy Scouts of America. Marcus is Field Director, Heart of Virginia Council of BSA.

Marcus job includes community outreach letting folks know about Scouting, what Scouts are doing in the area, and training of volunteers & scout leaders. The goal of Scouting is to provide young men with ethical & moral choices in life.

Marcus outlined the levels of scouting: Cub Scouts (grades 1©5) 1st grade dens are Tigers, 2nd grade wolves, 3rd grade Bears, and 4th grades Webelos. The Webelos program gets scouts ready to participate & lead in the next level Boy Scouts. Boy Scouts are boys from grade 6 to their 18th birthday. Volunteers assist the scouts; however, they do their own planning & running of events. There are other BSA supported activities in addition to scouting that are co-ed: VENTURING - groups in our area do kayaking & one does a youth ministry program, EXPLORING - volunteers work with co-ed youth for career training for example: hospitals support nursing training, Dominion VA Power has an engineering program, and local Sheriff's & law offices offer training in law & law enforcement.

Marcus informed that the district level aids & coordinates: membership & retention, finance, activities, training for leaders & volunteers, and maintaining the integrity of the advancement program. After his presentation, Marcus answered our questions and added the need for volunteer & financial support.

JULY 24 - Board of Directors Meeting - at the home of Lion President Glenn Pfluger - actions of the board are noted in appropriate areas of this report. This meeting was used to finalize our 2012-13 budget.

PROJECTS & SERVICES FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

Our fundraising is through hosting bingo every Friday night at the Bishop Ireton Center (Knights of Columbus). This effort requires a total of 30+ work hours weekly.
